JANUARY 25 - 29

- Contractors continue to pour concrete for the Hawthorne garage walls.
- The crafting of the Hawthorne garage columns will continue.
- Contractors will organize the drainage system for the Hawthorne garage.
- Electrical work will begin in the Hawthorne garage.
- Contractors will set up steel columns for the gatehouse this week.
- Beams will begin to be drilled in the Corrigan dining room.
- The demolition of Classroom 1 will commence this week. Please avoid this area and its adjacent walking path. They will be closed for the remainder of the Corrigan renovation.
